Yanni Announces 2003/4 World Tour

Yanni's patient yet eager fans will finally have the opportunity to see him perform live in concert again after a five-year break from touring and a period of almost total creative seclusion. The 2003/4 World Tour is scheduled to kick off in March, 2003 and will showcase many new and exciting Yanni compositions, from his soon-to-be-released *Ethnicity* album on Virgin Records as well as many old favorites.

As in the memorable *Live At The Acropolis* and *Tribute* tours, Yanni will be accompanied by his symphony orchestra and an elite group of multi-talented musicians from all over the world. The tour will celebrate the return of featured solo

artists Karen Briggs on violin, Pedro Eustache on flute and reed instruments, and for the first time since 1995, longtime friend Charlie Adams will again be demonstrating his exceptional skill on the drums. Yanni has also added several new and unique musical talents to complement his select group of gifted instrumentalists.. and he can't wait to showcase them all in concert. These artists, along with other members of Yanni's core band and symphony orchestra, will be more than ready to captivate audiences around the world once again this spring.

Yanni's recordings and concerts have been embraced in every corner of the world. He was the first western artist

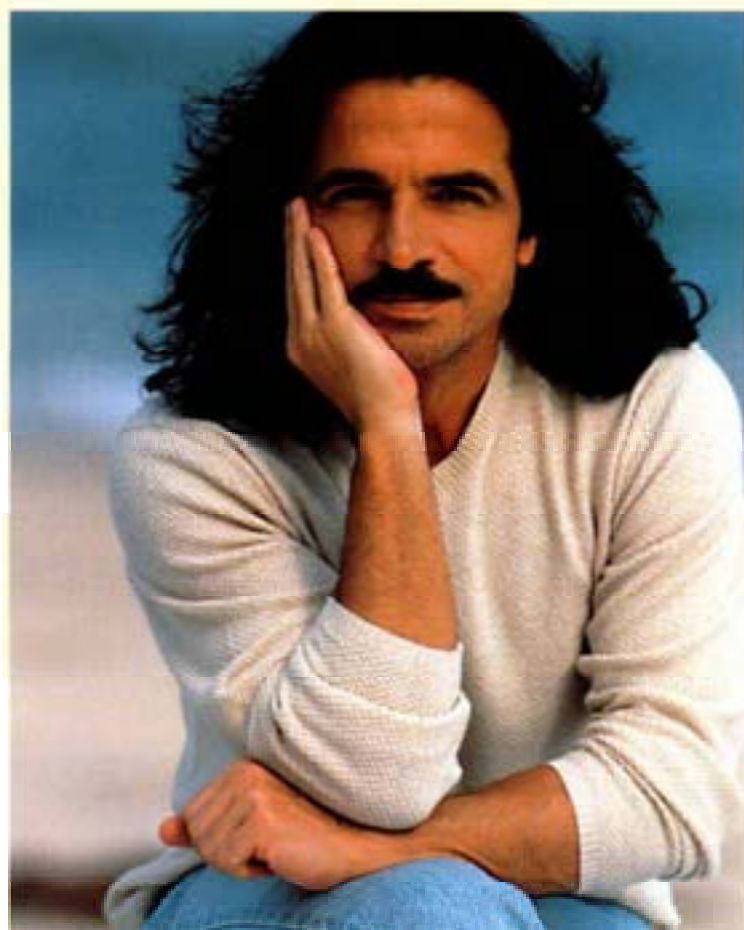


ever to be granted permission to perform at the Taj Mahal in India and the Forbidden City in China, which were featured on his *Tribute* PBS special and home video. Clearly, the music Yanni composes crosses and erases many cultural boundaries to create one human culture based on respect, tolerance and a common love for music.

The 2003/4 tour will feature many popular selections from past albums and tours, as well as compositions that have never been performed live. Audiences will be introduced to many exciting new sounds inspired by Yanni's creativity in blending musical flavors. In addition, fans can expect a few new visual surprises. Concerts are scheduled to begin in Las Vegas in March 2003, and will encompass more than 50 cities throughout North America.

Tickets will go on sale for most cities on December 9th and will be available from Ticketmaster or other outlets. Special pre-purchase opportunities will be offered to registered fan members for a limited time – please see the Fan Club box to the right. Yanni fans are encouraged to buy their tickets early as Yanni's last North American tour was one of the top concert tours of 1998. Tickets sold out quickly in many cities and additional dates had to be added. For instance, in New York Yanni sold out ten shows at Radio City Music Hall and then added additional arena dates in the New York area to cope with the demand. Be sure to visit www.yanni.com often to obtain the latest concert news and tour updates or to read first-hand accounts of fan's concert experiences as they post their stories on the Message Board.

The 2003/4 World Tour promises to be an exciting new venture for Yanni. He is looking forward to reuniting with his fans and doing what he does so well – bringing people together with his music.

In December 2002, Yanni will be returning to PBS with a new television special. In this intimate television special, Yanni performs with his band and full symphony orchestra at London's historic Royal Albert Hall, a majestic venue with world-renowned acoustics offering the perfect setting for this stunning symphonic experience.

Southern Greece where he grew up. Visit Yanni at his family home with his parents. See where he creates his music. There you will have a front row seat as Yanni performs two enchanting solo pieces at his grand piano.

With Emmy award winning producer/director George Veras overseeing this latest Yanni production, you'll be part of the excitement of his dramatic performance at the legendary Royal Albert Hall, which sparkles like an elegant jewel amidst the mosaic of musical talent.

Yanni will be making several appearances in selected PBS broadcast studios during their pledge drives this December to encourage member support of the public broadcasting network.
